# AB.M1J Baltic aphotic mixed substrate characterized by epibenthic sponges

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### **Textual description**

Baltic aphotic bottoms with 10-90 % coverage of hard (rock/boulders/stone) and 10-90 % soft substrata (e.g. muddy/coarse sediment/sand). Sessile/semi-sessile epibenthic sponges cover at least 10 % of the seabed and more than other perennial attached erect groups.

#### Physical environment

Substrate is soft or crystalline rock, boulders or stones mixed with mobile substrates such as sand or coarse substrate. Depth is typically from 20 to 100 meters.

#### Characteristic species

Ephydatia fluviatilis
