

AB.H1G Baltic aphotic muddy sediment characterized by epibenthic cnidarians

Author

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Textual description

Baltic aphotic bottoms with at least 90 % coverage of muddy sediment. The sediment must contain at least 20 % of mud, silt or clay (grain size less than 63 µm). Sessile/semi-sessile epibenthic cnidarians cover at least 10 % of the seabed and more than other perennial attached erect groups.

Physical environment

Substrate is muddy sediment. Depth below approximately 20 m. Appears in all energy exposure classes.
